This is our second vintage of Pinot Noir sourced from the Doña Margarita Vineyard in Green Valley of Russian River the premier growing region for this varietal in Sonoma.

It's name represents the ten "grand"children of the Kelleher Family. A classic cool climate Pinot Noir, this wine shows delicate fruit with beautiful acidity.

TASTING NOTES

Classic Burgundian hints of tomato leaf along with fresh raspberry and cherry blossom are prominent on the nose.

The palate brings more complex fruit of black plum and pomegranate, and a silky mouth feel. The tannins are soft and elegant with very balanced acidity, making this wine versatile for drinking in it's youth with potential to age for 5-6 years.
